

Instrument Matching

Match the Instrument with its Description.

Violin	Is held like a violin but is slightly larger
Viola	The member of the string family with the highest pitch
Cello	A slender tube of silver that produces sound when air is blown over the mouthpiece
Double Bass	A member of the string family that you sit down to play
Flute	A wooden cylinder that produces sound when air is blown through a thin shaved piece of wood called a reed
Clarinet	Brass instrument with three valves that help control pitch
Oboe	The largest member of the string family
French Horn	Uses a double-reed and is very similar in shape to the clarinet
Trumpet	Metal tubing wrapped in coils with a flared bell
Trombone	Brass instrument that uses a slide to change pitch
Tuba	Metal wires are stretch across this drum to give it a rattling sound
Snare Drum	The largest instrument in the brass family
Timpani	Large drums that are also called "kettle drums"
